

## **SITE PRIVACY POLICY:**

### **ARTICLE 1: PREAMBLE**

This privacy policy applies to the site: <https://blogklink-pc.tech/en>.

The purpose of this privacy policy is to expose users of the site to:

- How their personal data is collected and processed. All data that may identify a user should be considered personal data. These include first name and name, age, postal address, email address, user's location or IP address;
- What are users' rights to this data?
- Who is responsible for processing personal data collected and processed; To whom this
- data is transmitted;
- Eventually, the site's "cookie" file policy.

### **ARTICLE 2: GENERAL PRINCIPLES FOR DATA COLLECTION AND PROCESSING**

In accordance with The provisions of Article 5 of the European Regulations 2016/679, the collection and processing of data of users of the site respects the following principles:

- The privacy, loyalty and transparency: data can only be collected and processed with the consent of the user who owns the data. Whenever personal data is collected, the user will be told that their data is being collected, and why their data is being collected;
- Limited purposes: data collection and processing are executed to meet one or more objectives identified in these terms and conditions of use;
- Minimizing data collection and processing: only the data needed to

Good execution of the objectives pursued by the site are collected;

- Time-reduced data retention: Data is stored for a limited time, which the user is informed of. When this information cannot be disclosed, the user is informed of the criteria used to determine the shelf life;
- Integrity and confidentiality of data collected and processed: the data handler is committed to ensuring the integrity and confidentiality of the data collected.

In order to be lawful, and in accordance with the requirements of Article 6 of the European Regulation 2016/679, the collection and processing of personal data can only take place if it meets at least one of the following conditions listed:

- The user expressly consented to the treatment;
- Treatment is necessary for the proper execution of a contract;
- The treatment meets a legal obligation;
- The treatment is explained by a need to safeguard the vital interests of the person concerned or another individual;
- Treatment may be explained by a necessity related to the performance of a public interest mission or which is part of the exercise of public authority;
- The processing and collection of personal data is necessary for the purposes of legitimate and private interests pursued by the person in charge of the processing or by a third party.

### **ARTICLE 3: PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED AND PROCESSED AS PART OF SITE NAVIGATION**

#### **A. CollectED AND METED AND COLLECTE MODE Personal data**

This data is collected when the user performs one of the following operations on the site:

- When the user completes the comment form

The processing manager will keep all the data collected for a period of: 3 months in his computer systems at the site and under reasonable security conditions.

## **B. DATA TRANSMISSION HAS THIRD PARTIES**

The personal data collected by the site is not transmitted to any third parties, and is only processed by the site's publisher.

The data collected and processed by the site is exclusively hosted and processed in France.

## **ARTICLE 4: DATA PROCESSING MANAGER AND DATA PROTECTION DELEGATE**

### **A. THE PERSON IN CHARGE OF DATA PROCESSING**

The person in charge of processing personal data is Yves KLINGER. It can be contacted as follows:

The data handler is responsible for determining the purposes and means of processing personal data.

### **B. OBLIGATIONS OF THE DATA HANDLER**

The processing manager is committed to protecting the personal data collected, not transmitting it to third parties without the user being informed, and respecting the purposes for which the data was collected.

The site has an SSL certificate to ensure that information and the transfer of data transiting through the site are secure.

An SSL ("Secure Socket Layer" Certificate) is intended to secure the data exchanged between the user and the site.

In addition, the data handler undertakes to notify the user in the event of a correction or deletion of the data, unless this entails disproportionate formalities, costs and procedures for the user.

In the event that the integrity, confidentiality or security of the user's personal data is compromised, the processing manager undertakes to inform the user by any means.

## C. THE DATA PROTECTION DELEGATE

In addition, the user is informed that the next person has been appointed Data Protection Delegate: Yves KLINGER.

The role of the Data Protection Delegate and ensuring the proper implementation of national and supranational provisions on the collection and processing of personal data. He can also be appointed DPO (for Data Protection Officer).

## ARTICLE 5: USER RIGHTS

In accordance with the regulations regarding the processing of personal data, the user has the following rights listed.

In order for the data handler to grant the request, the user is obliged to communicate to him: his first and last name as well as his email address.

The data handler is required to respond to the user within a maximum of 30 (thirty) days.

### A. PRESENTATION OF USER RIGHTS TO DATA COLLECTION AND PROCESSING

#### *a. Right of access, rectification and right to erasure*

The user can review, update, modify or request the deletion of the data about him, in accordance with the following procedure:

The user must send an email to the person in charge of processing personal data, specifying the purpose of their request and using the contact [at] email address klink-pc.fr

#### *b. Right to data portability*

The user has the right to request the portability of his personal data, held by the site, to another site, by complying with the following procedure:

The user must send an email to the person in charge of processing personal data, specifying the purpose of their request and using the contact [at] email address klink-pc.fr

#### *c. Right to limit and oppose data processing*

The user has the right to request the limitation or to object to the treatment of his data by the

site, without the site being able to refuse, except to demonstrate the existence of legitimate and compelling grounds, which may prevail over the interests and rights and freedoms of the user.

In order to request the limitation of the processing of its data or to make an objection to the processing of its data, the user must follow the following procedure:

The user must send an email to the person in charge of processing personal data, specifying the purpose of their request and using the contact [at] email address klink-pc.fr

*d. Right not to be decided solely on an automated process*

In accordance with the provisions of regulation 2016/679, the user has the right not to be the subject of a decision based exclusively on an automated process if the decision produces legal effects concerning him, or affects him in a similar way.

*e. Right to determine the fate of data after death*

The user is reminded that he can arrange the fate of his data collected and processed if he dies, in accordance with Law No. 2016-1321 of October 7, 2016.

*f. Right to refer the matter to the relevant supervisory authority*

In the event that the data handler decides not to respond to the user's request, and the user wishes to challenge this decision, or, if he thinks that one of the rights listed above is infringed, he is entitled to refer the matter to the CNIL (National Commission for Information Technology and Freedoms, <https://www.cnil.fr>) or any competent judge.

## **B. PERSONAL DATA OF MINORS**

In accordance with the provisions of Article 8 of the European Regulation 2016/679 and the Computer Science and Freedoms Act, only minors aged 15 and over can consent to the processing of their personal data.

If the user is a minor under the age of 15, the consent of a legal representative will be required so that personal data can be collected and processed.

The publisher of the site reserves the right to verify by any means that the user is over 15 years of age, or that he will have obtained the consent of a legal representative before browsing the site.

## **ARTICLE 6: USE OF "COOKIES" FILES**

The site eventually uses "cookies" techniques.

A "cookie" is a small file (less than 4KB), stored by the site on the user's hard drive, containing information about the user's browsing habits.

These files allow it to process statistics and traffic information, facilitate navigation and improve service for user comfort.

For the use of "cookie" files involving the backup and analysis of personal data, the user's consent is necessarily required.

This user consent is considered valid for a maximum of 13 (thirteen) months. At the end of this period, the site will again ask the user's permission to save "cookie" files on its hard drive.

*a. User opposition to the site's use of "cookie" files*

It is brought to the user's knowledge that he may object to the registration of these "cookies" files by setting up his navigation software.
